## Short Term Certificate – STC SBD

## Program Locations: Bay Minette, Brewton, Thomasville, Monroeville, and Fairhope Campuses

Length: Two Semesters

The short-term certificate in Small Business/ Entrepreneurship introduces the principles of management and supervision, accounting concepts, and small business development skills. The certificate is designed to enable graduates of the program to enter lower-level management and accounting positions and prepare individuals for small business management.

This is a career program designed for students to go directly into the labor market upon completion. Although some of the courses in this program will transfer to four-year institutions, this program is not designed to be a transfer program of study; therefore, it is not subject to the terms and conditions of STARS.
